We wanted to provide you with this little gift for the new year from us and our Chiefs of Staff, Phyllis Mueller and Glenn Warren, of the Offices of the Mayors of Idyllwild.

This is our 2014 calendar for you. The Charter, Goals, and Purposes of the Offices of Mayor Max and the Mayors of Idyllwild

We have Idyllwild Animal Rescue Friends (ARF) to thank for creating the idea to have a dog or a cat elected as the Mayor of Idyllwild. Mayor Max, the First, won a two-year term in office which concludes on June 30, 2014. This mayoral office transitioned to the new Mayors of Idyllwild when, on April 2, 2013, Mayor Max, the First, passed away peacefully in his sleep due to old age. The new Mayors, direct descendants of Mayor Max's lineage, took over on July 21, 2013, to continue his legacy and complete the two-year term in office.

The goal and purpose of the Office of Mayor Max is to convey unconditional love and to do as many good deeds for others as possible. We want to bring joy, happiness, and fun communication to everyone in the community. We believe that positive energy leads towards life, and by doing good deeds and spreading positive, upbeat communication throughout the town, we can help to increase the well-being and longevity of every member of the community. We have spent as much time as possible sharing the Mayors with everyone via visits downtown in Idyllwild and other cities and counties, making personal visits and house calls to any and all requests that have been made from people on and off the Hill, and conducting ongoing communications via Facebook, email, telephone, and U.S. Mail. We have received thousands of responses from people thanking us for the joy we have brought to Idyllwild and their lives.

Upon Mayor Max being inaugurated, this charter was expanded to also include being heavily involved in the community, its events, and to promote Idyllwild and the cause of animal rights / animal rescue on and off the Hill. We have taken all of these charters to heart and have worked extensively on each of these initiatives. Mayor Max, the Mayors of Idyllwild, and Pookie too, have attended as many as 20 events per month since July 1, 2012. We have promoted Idyllwild to more than half a million people via emarketing campaigns. We have conducted nationwide press campaigns to let people know about Idyllwild, and we now manage a global database of people who monitor the Mayors' activities on a daily basis via email and Facebook.



Q4 2013—Throughout October, November, and December of 2013, the Mayors of Idyllwild, staff, and Pookie too worked on many other events and activities. To mention only a few, these activities and events included weekly and often daily Tree Lighting meetings and activities, Idyllwild Gift Shop's 6th Annual Christmas Preview Event, Living Free Animal Sanctuary's "It's All About the Animals" Festival and Fundraiser, Rustic Theatre Children's Time Event, Idyllwild Fire Department's Open House and Fundraiser, Art Alliance of Idyllwild's Art and Wine Walk, Dog Day Sunday ARF Fundraiser at Baily Winery, Soroptimist Basket Festival Spaghetti Dinner Fundraiser, Heavenly Horse Haven's Chili Cook-off Event and Fundraiser, the Halloween Evening Event in Downtown Idyllwild, Idyllwild Village Market's Grand Opening, Forest Folk's Weekly Potluck Meeting, Peace

Light Ceremony at Camp Emerson, Rustic Theatre Popcorn Garland Measuring Event, Idyllwild Tourism Association's Initial Meeting, and Mountain Paws' Christmas Day Event, to mention only a few. In each month, we also (1) scheduled and conducted individual Mayoral visits whenever requested by visiting tourists, local residents, and for children's birthday parties and (2) scheduled time downtown daily at numerous locations to visit with and share the Mayors with local residents and visiting tourists.

The Mayors of Idyllwild, Pookie Mueller, and the Chiefs of Staff, Phyllis Mueller and Glenn Warren, each work long hours to provide joy to people, and we shall continue to do so to the best of our ability for the rest of our lives even when Mayor Max's mayoral term has ended.

Local shop owners also reported very high or highest-ever sales for their stores, and we are thrilled about that! The Mayors of Idyllwild and Pookie visited with everyone throughout the day.

This core team also includes Ken Dahleen, Denise Edmiston, John Edmiston, Mike Lackey, Brad Lauritzen, Virginia Lumb, Jim Manietta, Paul Riggi, Beth Severance, Marshall Smith, Omar Solorio, Gary Taylor, Chris Titus, Glenn Warren, and Wendy Watts. Thank you everyone for all your hard work. We appreciate your dedication of time and energy to help make this year's Tree Lighting Ceremony a great success.

Tree Lights—Over the past two years, Phyllis Mueller and Glenn Warren have funded the purchase of all new tree lights for Idyllwild. There are now 4000 lights on the tree. We were delighted to make this contribution to the community and to make the tree more beautiful than ever. We have received hundreds of compliments about the beauty of the tree this year via people just telling us, but also via Facebook, email, and Christmas cards we have received. Thank you everyone for your kind feedback. It really warms our hearts, and the Mayors and Staff are so appreciative of your kind thoughts.

Getting the Tree Lights Up and Down the 100-Foot Tree— The hardest part of managing the Tree Lighting Ceremony is actually getting the lights up and down the tree. Omar Solorio, our very brave local tree climber, risked his life again and spends more than six hours in the tree each time. We also have a crew of 10 people at the bottom of the tree to facilitate getting the lights up and down to Omar. This year's team included all of the following individuals: Enrique Sanchez, Gary Weber, Hal Dahlstrom, Joe McNabb, LuAnn Drury, Mike Drury, Omar Solorio, Paul Riggi, Phyllis Mueller, Rafael Ramirez, and Tatum Eich.

Keeping the Tree Lights Lit—Paul Riggi continues to be the most important person regarding getting the tree lights to all work well and then keeping the lights so they stay on when

on the tree. There is quite a bit of ongoing work to do this, and Paul masterfully handles this area in every regard. This includes monitoring the tree and repairing tree lights as weather and wind definitely cause a great deal of movement on the tree, and this can cause damage to the lights and outages. Since the lights went up, Paul has made numerous trips to the tree to make the repairs—And the lights just look perfect and always on, right? You can thank Paul for that every time you see him!

Santa and Mrs. Claus and Their Workshops—Every year, Santa and Mrs. Claus make the trip from the North Pole to Idyllwild to visit over 300 children at Santa's Workshops on Tree Lighting Day. We sincerely appreciate their time and also the time of Marge Muir who works tirelessly to create a beautiful and fun Santa's Workshop for Santa and Mrs. Claus every year. Marge and her team of volunteers decorate the workshop trees, wrap packages, set up the workshop Christmas lights, and work it out so this is a delightful experience for all of the children who come to visit Santa. Santa and Mrs. Claus and their elves are to be commended for their tremendous contribution to the community. We want to thank Mike and Emily Pearson for being the truly excellent representatives of the true spirit of Christmas and for making their time available for this important event.

Event Promotion—Phyllis Mueller and Glenn Warren handled the creation, implementation, and funding of the promotional programs to ensure a great turnout at the Tree Lighting Ceremony. This includes outreach via email campaigns to 30,000 Southern California executives; a nationwide press release that was picked up by television, radio, and newspapers; communication to Mayor Max's private database of contacts developed over the past two years; personal outreach to Mayor Max's special media contacts that love the Mayors of Idyllwild and always generate press for us/Idyllwild; creating, copywriting, and distributing 2000 copies of this year's Tree Lighting Ceremony Program; frequent promotion of the event on Facebook to Mayor Max's 1400+ friends; and much more. Fundraising covered the cost of program printing and ads in the *Desert Entertainer*.

The Musical and Entertainment Program—The musical and entertainment program was created and led this year by Marshall Smith, who assembled and managed a team of highly-talented singers, musicians, and actors whose performances were truly wonderful and first-class in every respect. Many let us know that this year's program included the highest caliber of talent ever assembled.

Our Journey to Idyllwild

I, Mayor Max, get asked all the time why I was selected as the Mayor rather than Mikey or Mitzi. Here's what Phyllis, the Chief of Staff, told me:

ello! My name is Pookie Mueller. I am the Puppy Rearing Professional (PRP) for the Hooligan Mayors of Idyllwild that are now also known as the Hooligan Muelligans! I have raised these puppies since they were 8 and 10 pounds. They are wild dogs, that's for sure. I am proud of them.

When I first took charge of the Mayors in July 2013, they were little and liked to roughhouse with me. They liked to jump on me, bite my tail, bite me on the rump, and tackle me. I also learned to be very aggressive with the coyotes who were always coming around. I was so aggressive, I scared them, so they would run off. I have even bitten them. I also got a bite wound from one and had to get three stitches, but the coyote went away limping, so I won that fight.

My BFF Forever is Tashi, which makes her my BFFF.
