The Office of Mayor Max began with Mayor Max the First on July 1, 2012. The office continued on July 21, 2013 with Mayor Max the Second and Deputy Co-Mayors Mitzi and Mikey.

In 2014, we produced the Mayor's first calendar. It was so well received that we have continued this annual project since then. You can read all the calendars going back to 2014 by going to the calendar section of the Mayor's website at www.mayormax.com.

Today, the Office of Mayor Max continues with Mayor Max the Third, Vice Mayor Meadow the First, and the two Deputy Co-Mayors Mitzi and Mikey. The third generation of Mayor Max the Third and his sister, Vice Mayor Meadow the First, began on November 10, 2022 and continues to the present day.

The 2025 Mayor Max calendar is our 12th year of calendar production.

The calendars are free and are a gift from Phyllis Mueller and Glenn Warren to the Idyllwild community and Mayor Max friends around the globe. We print and prepare 10,000 calendars every year. We distribute 6000 copies in Idyllwild to residents and visitors. We mail 4000 every year to individuals in 33 countries who have requested them.

In 2024, we began receiving and fulfilling our first calendar requests from mainland China.

Though we send the calendars for free, we do very much appreciate donations for the calendars as that does help us in the funding of this initiative every year. It is financially challenging for us to do this project since it has grown to be so large. So if you can help, we appreciate it.

Every year, the calendar includes what we call "some of the secrets to the universe," helpful suggestions on how to live a happy and extraordinary life in challenging times. It includes how to accomplish goals. It includes what you can do to help create Peace on Earth in our lifetime.

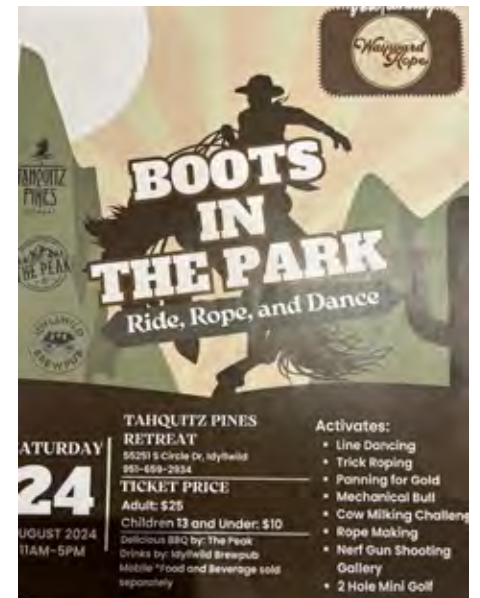

is the same as what would I say or do? I decided to put that in writing. The name of the book is, *Mayor Max, If I Were President*. This book does have a strategy for creating happiness and well-being for every individual on the planet.

I do believe I would be ideal for this job, but I did not figure this all out until a little bit late in life. It makes me wish I had studied harder in school!

I want you to know, though, that I have dedicated my life to helping others as much as possible, and I want to see and help to achieve peace on Earth for all mankind in my lifetime. If I don't make that happen, I do believe in past lives and future lives. I do believe we come back. When I come back next lifetime and in all future lifetimes, I plan to pick right up where I left off and continue to work on this. And I think I would make a run for it to see if I could achieve a high

level of office in politics, though I am not certain that a high-ranking political office would create more good than an individual outside of government. It is an intriguing proposition.

I do know that if anyone could have a positive impact on all the people of the Earth, I am one of the ones who could do it because I can conceive of things on the proper order of magnitude, and I can conceive of ways to do it. I don't think it's impossible. In fact, I think the only things that are impossible are the things you say are impossible because your thought is the determining characteristic of what happens in your life. If you think it can be done, you can make it happen. If you think it cannot be done, you won't even try.

I have been running spreadsheets for years on what it will cost to implement these types of programs for the whole planet. When I started doing this, there were 5 billion people on the planet. Now there are 8 billion. OK!

I think I can see a way to help all mankind.

In October 2023, Alex Robins, a playwright from the UK, contacted us and told me he wanted to come to Idyllwild because he wanted to write a play about Mayor Max. That's all he said, and I said fine because I say yes to all non-partisan, non-political people who want to meet Mayor Max and do anything with him, e.g., photos, movies, documentaries, social media posts, you name it. I pretty much never say no. Alex came to Idyllwild and spent time interviewing us and others in the community.

I had no idea what Alex was going to do, and I only gave it a little bit of thought. I wondered if it's a play, will there be a dog in it? Will it be a stuffed animal dog? Is there more than one person in the play? What will it be about? I had no idea, and that's where my thought ended. I didn't think about it much.

A year later, Alex contacted us in October 2024 and said he had completed the play, and it was entitled, *Mayor Max for President!*

Alex returned to Idyllwild and presented the play twice. I found it very impactful. It actually made me a better person and made me resolve to try even harder than I was. It revitalized me because in the day-to-day challenges of living, running a company, running the Office of Mayor Max, both of which are full-time jobs, I can sometimes get so involved in keeping up with the schedule challenges of our lives and the mechanics of day-to-day living that I might not be as active

in working on the global issues as much as I should be or would like to be.

We are challenged every day in our two worlds of making a living in our business to make enough money to afford to pay for our lives AND fund and run the Office of Mayor Max. I would love to be working exclusively to implement Mayor Max's POET initiative and his Peace on Earth Team program.

I was so moved by the play that I wish you could have seen it. If you would ever like to see the play, let Alex know. I have put his contact information here, and the next time he is in the US, perhaps he will stop by and present it to you in your town.

There is no need to be cruel or hateful to anyone. You can communicate any message with a loving heart, and that is the key toward survival for all of us. Positive energy

leads towards life. Negative energy goes in the opposite direction.

It has always been easy for me to put myself in the shoes of another person or the existence of another life form and imagine exactly what it would be like to experience what they are experiencing, feel what they are feeling. Because I can feel and

understand that, I have tremendous love and understanding for everyone and all life forms. I am a humanitarian that fights for human rights, and I am also an animal rights activist that believes that animals should have the same rights as humans, and even humans need more rights in many areas around the globe. I believe the souls of animals are the same as the souls of humans.

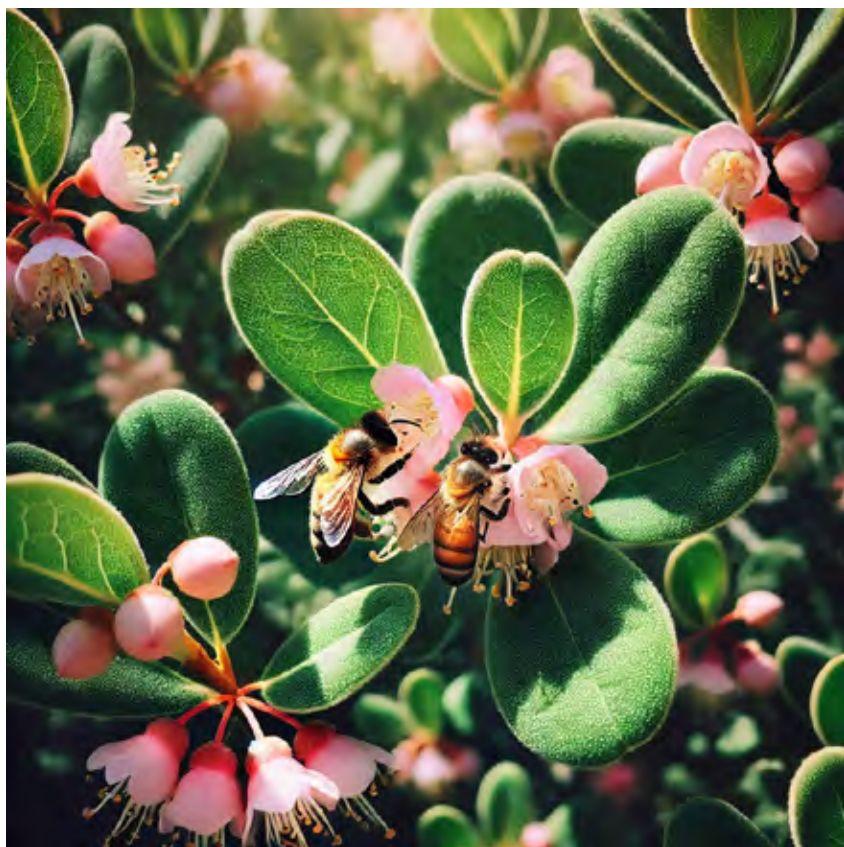
Because all kinds of little plants grow up in the dirt around me by my trunk, I get visited

The bunnies are amazing because they can squeeze through the tightest of spaces, and you can't believe it's possible, but they do it all the time. There are different kinds of bunnies too. We have these giant jackrabbits with huge ears, and they seem to be five times the size of a regular rabbit. The jackrabbits love to play punching games with their front legs. It's so funny. No one ever gets hurt, and both rabbits of each competition claim they are the winner!

In the spring, it's fun to see the baby rabbits. In the beginning, they are no bigger than a chicken egg. They sure are fast, and there are so many of them. Sometimes they come to visit me at the base of my tree trunk, and they take a nap together in the nice cool shade on a warm day. I just love how peaceful and serene

All of the bird species are very observant. The ravens sometimes like to hang around in groups of a couple hundred. The ravens are

very good at noticing all kinds of things to eat on the ground. For example, the Mayors of Idyllwild, four Golden Retrievers, enjoy having meals out on their deck that goes around the house. And when the Mayors eat, they always make some crumbs that fall outside of the bowl onto the deck floor but that also fall through the cracks in the wood panels of the deck. The owls also add some lovely hoo hoo hoos to the evening and also communicate with owls on other trees. They carry on all kinds of interesting conversations, mostly about where are you sleeping tonight. Sometimes, they love sleeping in the trees, but sometimes they like roof tops. Sometimes, they find

big holes in a tree, and they love that! They are very creative. There are even owls that like to burrow in holes in the ground if you can believe that!

One of my favorite friends is an owl called Sam. No one knows how he got his name, but he proudly tells everyone his name is Sam. Sam loves to fly at night and stand on my branches. I love looking at his fiery orange and yellow eyes that are always vibrating with movement and pulsating energy. I really enjoy seeing him and having our delightful conversations. His eyes are extraordinary to see, and there is so much life behind those eyes. He always talks about his flying adventures, and it makes me wish I could fly. But I love that they fly to me and that I get to be a resting point for every single kind of bird that lives in the mountains in California. I consider it an honor to be able to provide shelter and comfort to them.

The Steller's jays sometimes make a nest in my branches, and that is so much fun to watch for a season. I get to see them raise their children, and I can feel their nest on my branches. When they jump in the nest or the parents fly in, the nest gets a little heavier. When they take off and fly away, the nest gets lighter. The Steller's jays are very good at making sturdy nests—so even in high winds, their nests never blow out of the tree. Plus, I am a strong tree, and I can handle high winds.

I love the hummingbirds. Huey, Dewey, Louie, and Newey come by all the time, and they're always playing tag and racing around. They go so fast, I can hardly keep up with



them and see where they are and then they show up magically. They're so beautiful and the sun illuminates their beautiful iridescent feathers that explode with color. The colors are so pretty, I can't decide which colors are my favorite. I love the deep beautiful greens, purples, blues, reds, and oranges. The hummingbirds are always telling me how much they love the sweet nectar from my pink flowers. That makes me so happy to hear. I love seeing them, and I am always trying to make sure that I am making a lot of nectar for everyone that comes to visit.

I think it's so nice that I can share a common experience with humans. The bees take my pollen, and they make delicious honey from my flowers. The bees bring me back little droplets of honey that I can taste. People then jar the bees' honey so humans can buy the honey. Then, Phyllis and Glenn buy the local honey from my flowers. I always think how nice it is that Phyllis and Glenn are having breakfast enjoying some honey from my flowers. I feel at one with them like we are all part of the same family. Yes, I am certain I am part of their family.

I like that Phyllis, Glenn, and most humans seem to really admire the beauty of us Manzanita trees, our beautiful bark, exquisite flowers, and beautiful leaves. It's so nice to be appreciated.

We get visiting bobcats, of course, and they seem to always travel in twos. They're very cute and are always having conversations about what it would be like to have a long cat tail. They also often miss a meal because they get so excited when they see something they want to eat: they start squeaking and that alerts the animal to run. But fortunately, the bobcats also like to eat other plants and things that they find on the ground so there's always something delicious to eat. I noticed that bobcats enjoy nibbling on the apples that have fallen from the apple trees, the pine cones, and fresh newly green grasses. They also like to sip water from the ponds that people have or the little plastic swimming pools or dog water bowls. The bobcats really appreciate finding water wherever they go. Occasionally, the bobcats will also bite through a water hose to lap out precious drops of water to quench their thirst. They say that hose water is as delicious as every other type of water.

The bobcats like to nap on the ground under my branches in the

shade as well, and because they always travel in twos, it is a double pleasure.

I feel very safe and secure in my world. On a few occasions, I have even been visited by black bears who are usually traveling solo. The bears seem to love to come by and get a back scratch. They find some of my strongest branches, they stand on their hind legs, and they rub their back against my branches. I can tell how good it feels for them to be able to scratch their backs because we are somehow sharing the experience through a spiritual connection. I can really tell how good it feels to scratch that itch!

There's only one thing that makes me tremble a little bit, and it is the giant mountain lion that lives very close to where I live. When he comes by, I tremble a little bit and some of my petals from my flowers fall on the ground. But that's OK because when we have a rainstorm, the ants like to jump on the petals and go surfing as the water runoff goes down the driveway to the street and further down to the creeks and ponds. The

ants thoroughly enjoy their surfing experience because the petals are like little boats that float on the water. You can hear the ants going "Wheeeeeeeee!" or "hang six" all the way as they pass by. It's a joy to see how happy they are having fun using my petals as little boats and surfboards on the rainwater.

I had always thought that one mountain lion was daunting to watch. I am just in awe of the mountain lions. They're so majestic. It's not really fear I experience when I see them. It is the tremendous respect



I have for their awesomeness and how beautiful and intense they are and how confident they are. I think they are some of the most beautiful creatures I have ever seen.

One time, five mountain lions came all at once. The mountain lions lounged under my branches

but also a little bit outside my branch area. It was a mommy, daddy, and three grown mountain lions that were young and only about a year old. They were having a family adventure and were being extremely curious.

One of the youngsters somehow knew I was a little intimidated by their fierceness. So he stood up on his hind legs putting his front legs up toward the top of me, and he looked me right in the leaves! Yowzer! I did faint for just a few seconds. I survived it.

After lounging by me for a few hours, the mountain lions went on the deck of a neighbor's house very nearby and kept looking in the windows of the house. One of them actually stood on its hind legs and pawed on the window glass with his front legs. The mountain lions and I could definitely hear the animated screams and screeches of the humans in the house who were riveted by this experience and hiding behind a doorway but peering out to see what the mountain lions were doing. The humans were hoping the window glass would hold and keep the mountain lions out of the house, and they were speaking with excitement and a little bit of concern. But the mountain lions were just having fun. We decided to grow our roots in all directions, but in the directions between Merrily and me, we grew our roots so we could touch each other's roots and "hold roots," synonymous for humans as "holding hands." As we got stronger and taller, our tree roots became like strong arms that we could hold in an embrace for every minute of every day. It is like having a full-time hug from the person you love the most. What a wonderful thing to experience. I knew I was the luckiest Manzanita tree that ever lived.

We even have the ability to move our roots so we can give each other little taps that say, "I love you."

Merrily is the most beautiful Manzanita that I have ever seen. Growing up, I noticed when the wind was blowing, she would use her strength to form her branches into the most beautiful curving shapes almost like legs and arms of a ballerina or the lithe mountain lion

in a morning stretch.

It was important to Merrily to have beautiful curvatures in her branches. So on windy days while other Manzanita trees were content to let the wind form their shapes, Merrily held her position against the wind so that she could maintain the artful shapes of her branches just the way she wanted them.

Something else you may not know about trees is that the wind can blow us in a direction, but we also have the ability to move our branches should we choose to do so. So in the evenings when Merrily and I rest and no one is watching, we gently bend our trunks and our branches toward each other, and we "hold hands" via our branches so that we are in lovely gentle physical contact throughout the night. This is our secret that we cherish.

One night, there was quite a fast and sudden downpour. A young rabbit was caught in the runoff and was being whisked away. Merrily and I saw it happening right in our direction, and we jumped into immediate action. We both bent our tree trunks and our branches to touch the ground giving the rabbit something to climb onto. Once the rabbit was safely in our branches, we raised our branches off the ground and out of the water. We held the rabbit until the downpour was over, and it was safe for him to hop around on the ground again. The rabbit was very grateful for our help.

He promised to bring over his family in the morning so they could all say thank you. Like most rabbits, his name was Hoppy which is a synonym in bunny-speak for Happy!

We were delighted to meet Hoppy's family in the morning. It was easy to remember their names. He brought over 79 relatives. What a great day of celebration. They cheered, they ate the grasses and plants under and around Merrily and me, and they napped. Seventy-nine napping rabbits with 18 that snored. They all slept with smiles on their faces. It was a magical experience that I will never forget.

As Merrily and I became adult trees, we decided we wanted to have as many children as possible. So we made a plan to produce as many seeds as possible and then to enlist the support of squirrels and birds to take our seeds around our region to help get them planted. Because of the spiritual connection we Manzanitas have with our seeds, each time a seedling of ours would pop out of the

ground, we would hear the Manzanita cheer: "Hello I'm here. Hello is my cheer!" Merrily and I would then know that another one of our children had been born.

Merrily and I are able to stay in constant spiritual connection with all of our children. Today, we have over 187 confirmed children as part of our family. We love being in communication with them, and they love being Manzanita trees too. They find it an exciting adventure every day.

If you ever want to be a Manzanita tree during one of your many lives, I highly recommend it. There is never one dull second, and you have hundreds of friends that come to see you and talk to you every day!

All year, we get other hikers that travel from north to south via the same route. The hike is 2,650 miles long and takes around six months to complete for many hikers. Approximately 8,000 hiking permits were issued last year for the PCT.

Idyllwild is a stopping ground for these hikers, and they love to see Mayor Max, and we love to see them. The hikers are so friendly, extroverted, and upbeat. Some stay for days as they recover from blisters, and we get to see them multiple times.

Phyllis likes to ask how long it has been since they have had a shower. So far, eleven days is the longest.

If you cannot find the trail or see it, do not go forward. Get help, join a group, turn around. The important part is to hike what you can handle safely, and skip those few parts that put you at risk. Go around the problem areas. Love, Grumpy

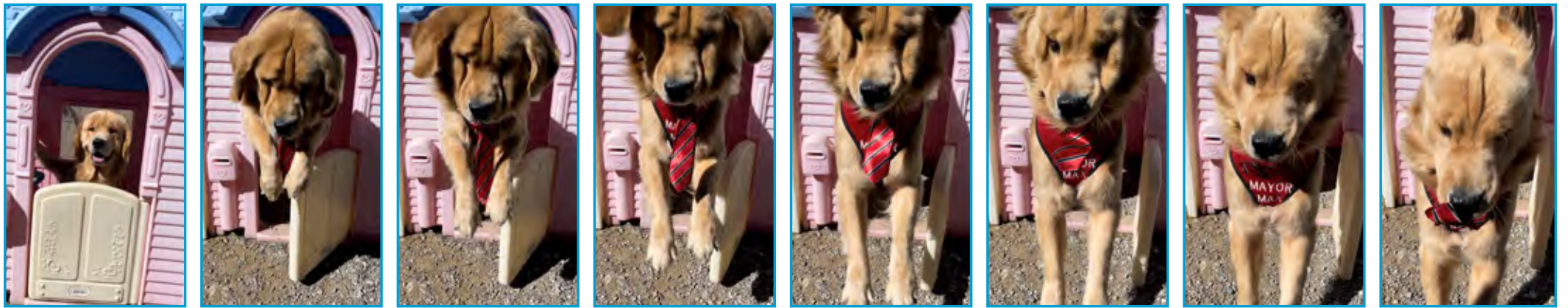

That is a little bit about my dear friends, Huey and Dewey.

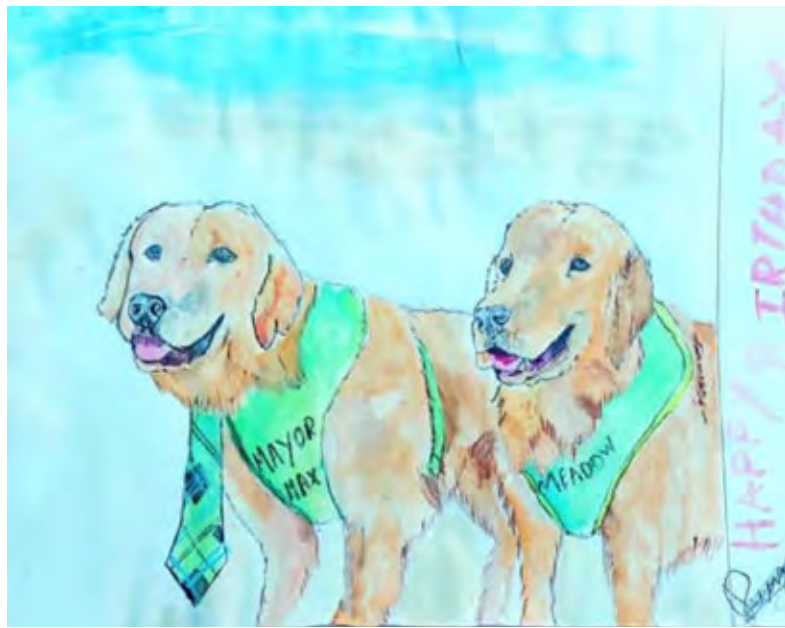

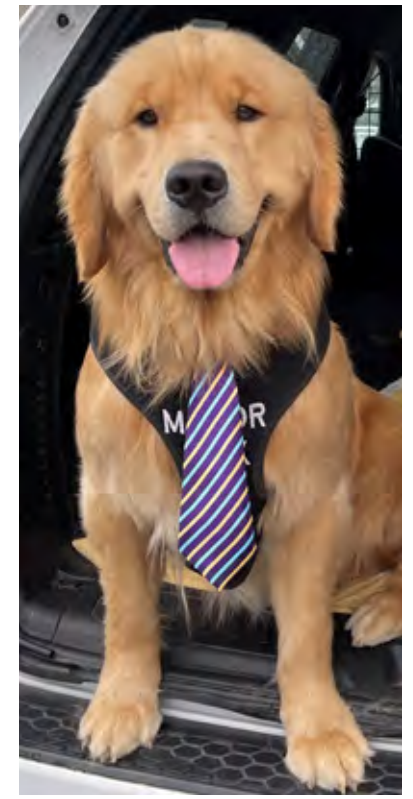

King Zebra's daughter and everyone in the kingdom lived happily every after, and zebras walked the land and lived in every household.

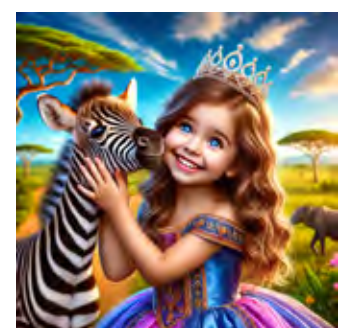
